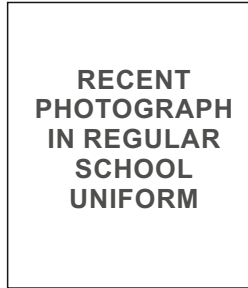

General Discipline

1. Both parents and pupils should keep in mind the following principles of discipline laid down by the Secondary School Code (1973) Section VIII, 56 : "Pupils should realize that they are responsible to the school authorities not only for their conduct in school, but that also for their general behavior outside . Any reported or observed objectionable conduct of pupils , out of school shall make them liable to disciplinary action." The school management has the sole right to decide the conditions , under which to admit or retain pupils in the school .
2. All are expected to speak in English within the school premises . After three warnings students will have to face the given punishment .
- 3.If any pupil is found in the possession of fire crackers, water pistols, magazines, posters, pictures, mobile phones, computer, games, ipods, etc. in the school premises they will be liable for severe punishment .
4. Parents should send their ward to school regularly, on time and in school proper school uniform.
- 5.Pupils must be punctual. Late remark will be given if pupils arrive after the reporting time .
6. Parents should encourage active participation of their ward in all co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.
7. Parents are expected to maintain the decorum of the school by being calm and polite while interacting with the school staff.
8. Parents should participate in all school meetings, open house to ensure your ward's progress.
9. Students should bring books according to the timetable. They should avoid carrying unnecessary things in the school bag. The weight of school bag should not be more than 10% of the child's weight.
- 10.The school calendar should be brought to school daily.
11. Parents are expected to daily check the school calendar of their ward and sign wherever remarks are given by the teachers and Headmistress.
12. Personal hygiene and cleanliness must be maintained by the pupil at all cost. Nails of students will be checked every Monday.
- 13.Pupils are strictly not permitted to wear bindis, nose rings, dangling earring, bangles and anklets to school .Applying Mehndi on hands, nail paint, nail art or tattoo is strictly prohibited.
14. Parents are requested to send a maximum of two toffees or stationery items to be distributed, not exceeding Rs 10/ on their ward's birthday. If you wish, you can donate a book to the library.
15. Any collection must be sent to the class Teacher in a sealed envelope with the name of the pupil, class, division and roll no. clearly mentioned on it.
16. Parents/Guardians should direct any feedback/suggestions that they may have to the Headmistress and not to the teachers.
17. Parents/Guardians are not allowed to go to the class or have a meeting with the teachers during school hours.
18. When writing any grievance letter to the Headmistress, parents are requested to mention the name of the pupil, class and division in which their ward is studying. Anonymous letters will not be entertained.
19. Parents are requested to inform the school immediately, about a change of address or telephone numbers. A written application addressed to the Headmistress along with the necessary documentary evidence should be submitted to School office.
20. Teachers are not permitted to give tuitions, kindly do not approach them for the same.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE

1. Students are expected to be in the school 10 minutes before the school timings without fail.
2. 80% attendance is compulsory in each semester.
3. Attendance on the re - opening day and the last working day of each vacation (Summer/Ganesh Utsav /Diwali) is mandatory.
4. A student should not remain absent from the school, except in case of an emergency.
5. In the case of leave involving three days or less the parent should write a note in the Leave of Absence Record.
6. In case of continued absence due to sickness /or any other emergency the school should be informed within 3 days and an application of leave of absence should be sent along with student.
7. If the student is ill or suffering from any contagious or infectious disease, he/she will not be allowed to attend school. The child should not be sent to school till he/she is cured of the infection. At the time of resuming school, the student must produce a medical fitness certificate.

PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION (P.T.A.)

- 1) The P.T.A. is an important part of our school and we look forward for their co-operation and support
- 2) The relation between the school and its PTA is of respect and the same should be reflected in all Interaction and communication.
- 3) The PTA is a valuable link between the school and the parents. It is expected that the PTA should communicate the feedback of parents to the school and also convey the concerns of the school to the parents.
- 4) Parental suggestions will always be welcome by the school, but the final decision about implementation of those suggestions will be at the discretion of the school.
- 5) PTA members will be elected class wise by the parents.

————— **ADMISSIONS.** —————

1) Admissions from class Nursery to Class One, original birth certificate is compulsory.

2) Admissions from Class Two onwards previous class marksheet and original school leaving certificate is compulsory

3 All admissions of Class Two onwards will be treated as provisional admission till the receipt of the School Leaving Certificate (S.L.C), from the previous school and the last date for the submission is 30th June. In case the (S.L.C) is not received with in the stipulated time, the management has the right to revoke the admission.

4) A child coming from school within the State of Maharashtra must produce the School Leaving Certificate in the format specified by the Government of Maharashtra in the GR No Sankirn - 2316/(229/16)/5D - 4.

5) A child coming from another State or another Board must produce the S.L.C. counter signed by the Education Inspector of the area in that state. The S.L.C must have the UDISE Code of the previous school and the UID Number of the Child or the UDISE Code and the Affiliation details of the previous school.

————— **WITHDRAWLS** —————

1. Application for School Leaving Certificate, withdrawal is available in the school office. It should be signed by both the parents/ guardian.

2. Application for withdrawal has to be made in writing 30 days in advance before the actual date of withdrawal, failing which, one months fee has to be paid as notice fees.

3. The School Leaving Certificate (S.L.C.) will be given to the applicant with in 10 working days, from the receipt of the application.
